THE HISTORY: Tony was one of Arsenal's **greatest ever** captains. For 14 years he lead the team and lifted 10 major trophies. Players looked up to him because of his **attitude** and **determination**.

THE CHALLENGE: Write a description of a **Perfect Captain**. Describe all the attributes a great leader would have and how they would react in difficult situations.

**EXAMPLE**: A Perfect Captain must lead by example. If a team is playing <u>badly</u> it is the captain's responsibility to lift the spirits of the side. A good leader will make <u>difficult</u> decisions at important times.

Captains must be aware of how their team is feeling and performing. They must have <u>excellent</u> communication skills and stay positive even in challenging situations.

A fine example of a great captain's performance is <u>when</u> <u>Tony Adams scored the winner</u> in the FA Cup semi-final against Tottenham. With ten minutes to go the defender came up with a <u>vital</u> goal when the team needed it most.
