Club Atlético de Madrid is a Spanish football club based in Madrid that plays in the Primera División of La Liga. Its home stadium is the Estadio Metropolitano, which currently holds 67,803 spectators.

The Club is one of the most successful in Spanish League history, having won both La Liga (Spanish League) and the Copa del Rey (King's Cup) ten times, including a double in 1995/1996.

Atlético also won the European Cup Winners Cup in 1962 and were European championships runner-up in 1974, 2014 and 2016, and Intercontinental Cup winners in 1974.





Travel Information

GETTING TO ESTADIO METROPOLITANO

Estadio Metropolitano is located approximately 12km from the city centre and has a variety of transport links:

FROM CENTRAL MADRID

There are numerous bus and Subway links to Estadio Metropolitano. Transport tickets are NOT included with match tickets.

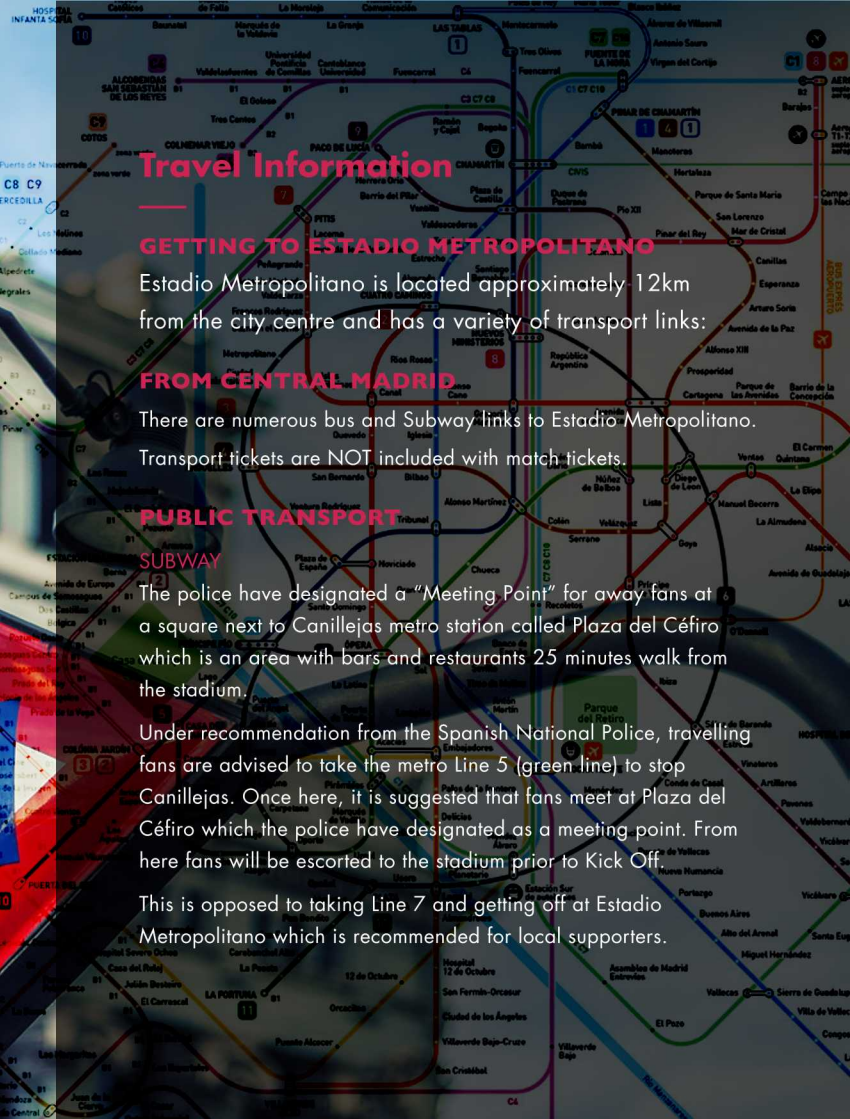

The police have designated a “Meeting Point” for away fans at a square next to Canillejas metro station called Plaza del Céforo which is an area with bars and restaurants 25 minutes walk from the stadium.

Under recommendation from the Spanish National Police, travelling fans are advised to take the metro Line 5 (green line) to stop Canillejas. Once here, it is suggested that fans meet at Plaza del Céforo which the police have designated as a meeting point. From here fans will be escorted to the stadium prior to Kick Off.

This is opposed to taking Line 7 and getting off at Estadio Metropolitano which is recommended for local supporters.



Stadium Access, Information & Security

Estadio Metropolitano will open at 19:00. Fans are advised to arrive at least one hour before the start of the match as there are three checks before fans can enter the stadium which can take a long time to complete. These include a ticket check, body/bag search and a banner check.

Estadio Metropolitano operates a reserved seating ticketing system so fans must sit in the seats that they are issued on their ticket.

Names and passport numbers will be printed on each ticket issued by Arsenal Football Club. Therefore it is required all fans carry photographic identification at all times during their stay in Spain.

No supporter will be allowed into the stadium without a photographic ID that correlates to the name on the ticket.

Arsenal stewards will be on hand to offer assistance and translation where possible.

Full body searches will be carried out by Spanish stewards. The process will be thorough and time consuming.

No left-luggage facilities are available and only small ladies' handbags are permitted. **NO OTHER BAGS ARE PERMITTED. THIS INCLUDES RUCKSACKS.** There are no storage facilities for bags or belongings, therefore it is highly advised **NOT** to bring bags with you.



Stadium Access, Information & Security

The following items are banned in the stadium and will be confiscated:



Banners and flags displaying anything which can be construed as racist or homophobic



Fireworks & Flares



Flagpoles & Sticks



Alcoholic drinks, bottles, glasses and cans



Knives, lighters, chains, coins, paper rolls or any other objects which can be thrown or used as weapons

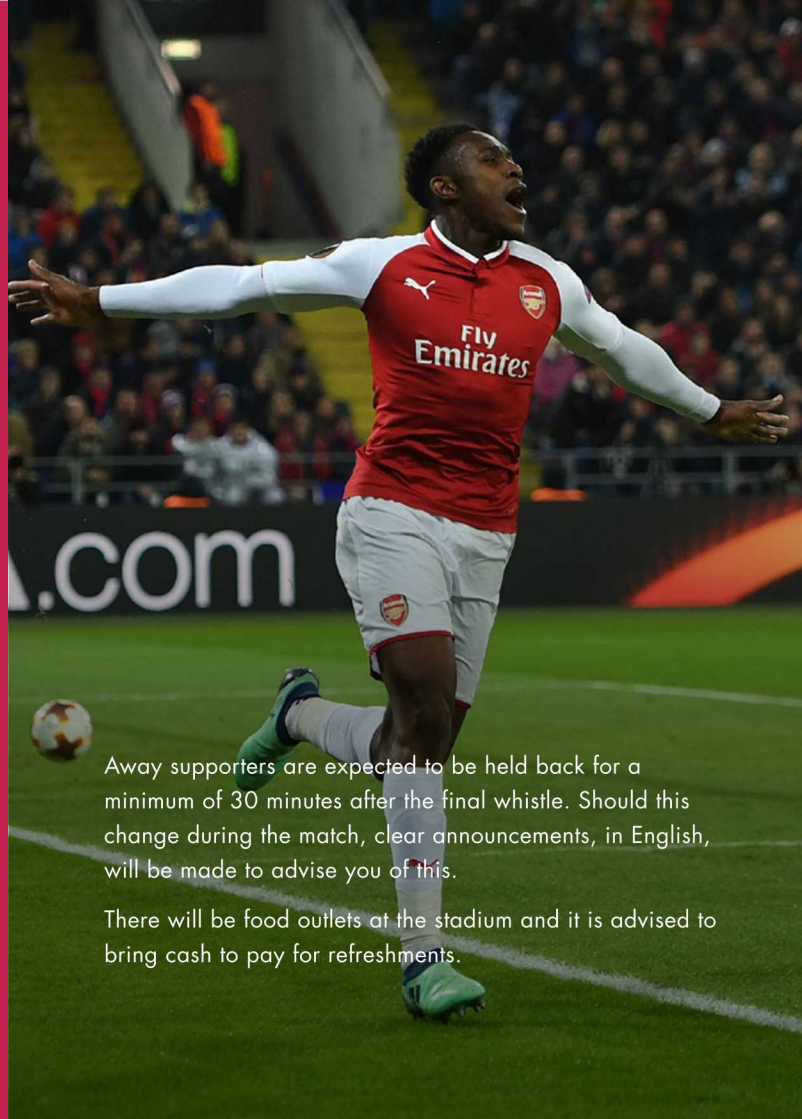


Megaphones and drums

There is limited space within the stadium for hanging flags and banners and these must not exceed 3m in length or 2m in width.

Smoking is not permitted within the stadium.

Stadium security reserves the right to remove all visitors that fail to comply with the regulations of the stadium.



Away supporters are expected to be held back for a minimum of 30 minutes after the final whistle. Should this change during the match, clear announcements, in English, will be made to advise you of this.

There will be food outlets at the stadium and it is advised to bring cash to pay for refreshments.
