

JORDAN NOBBS MIDFIELDER



Jordan Nobbs has been a vital member of the Arsenal team since joining from Sunderland a decade ago. Since making her Arsenal debut in 2010, the energetic midfielder has played over 100 times for the club and has become a leader in the dressing room.

The dynamic midfielder was named Women's Player of the Year at the London Football Awards in 2018. She has won 12 major trophies in her time with Arsenal so far. In 2020 the vice-captain signed a new contract. "Arsenal is my everything now," said Jordan after putting pen to paper.
