CREATIVE CHALLENGE **DIAMANTE POEM**

There are lots of different structures for poems. **Diamante** poems follow the pattern shown in the example below. Try to come up with some diamante poems of your own. They should be about **two nouns** which are **linked together** in some way, like Guendouzi and Arsenal. Your poems doesn't have to be about football.

You can write on plain paper or our **Writing Template**.

STRUCTURE:

Noun 1.
Adjective, Adjective.
Verb, Verb, Verb.
Noun, Noun, **Noun, Noun.**
Verb, Verb, Verb.
Adjective, Adjective.
Noun 2.

EXAMPLE:

Arsenal
Red, White,
Competing, Unifying, Winning.
Community, Team, **Midfielder, Fighter.**
Sprinting, Tackling, Shooting.
Brave, Determined.
Guendouzi.



PRO TIPS

IMAGINATIVE – Make it original; completely different from any poem that exists!

SPELLING CHECK – Be careful with your spelling. Look words up or ask someone if you're not sure.

NOUNS – Make sure your nouns are linked together e.g. ball and goal, sun and rain, day and night, etc.
