Travel Information

GETTING TO THE RAJKO MITIĆ STADIUM

The Rajko Mitić Stadium is located 3.5km from the main railway and city centre.

From Central Belgrade

Under recommendation from FC Red Star Belgrade and the local police authority, the Club will be providing transportation from the city centre to the Rajko Mitić Stadium before the match. Coaches will pick up fans from Student Square in central Belgrade and drop off at the Rajko Mitić Stadium.

At the end of the match, there will also be coaches returning fans back to the Student Square. More information regarding how to book is now available at www.arsenal.com/tickets/arsenal-european-travel

There are bus links to the Rajko Mitić Stadium, but these are limited and extremely busy on match days.

Transport tickets are NOT included with match tickets.

Taxis

Licensed taxis can be identified by having 'TX' at the end of the number plate. Scams and overcharging are not uncommon.

Parking

There is no designated car parking facility for away supporters.

Stadium Access, Information & Security

The Rajko Mitić Stadium will open at 17:00. You are advised to ensure you arrive well before the start of the match as ticket and security checks can take a long time to complete.

Please note that the approach to the stadium is along a dusty track and is uneven underfoot, so extra care should be taken when walking to the stadium.

Arsenal stewards will be on hand to offer assistance and translation where possible.

All away supporters, except VIPs and sponsors, will enter the stadium via Gate 25.

Full body searches will be carried out by Serbian security. The process will be thorough and time consuming. Please expect to go through 2 different check points before entering the stadium. No left-luggage facilities are available, and only small bags will be allowed into the stadium.





Stadium Access, Information & Security

The following items are banned in the stadium and will be confiscated:



Banners and flags displaying anything which can be construed as racist or homophobic



Fireworks & Flares



Flagpoles & Sticks



Alcoholic drinks, bottles, glasses and cans



Knives, belts, chains or any objects which can be thrown or used as a weapon



Megaphones and drums

There is limited space within the stadium for hanging flags and banners.

Smoking is permitted within the stadium. If you wish to smoke, please bring matches as lighters are banned.

Away supporters are expected to be held back after the final whistle for at least one hour. Should this change during the match, clear announcements will be made to advise you of this.

There will be food outlets at the stadium but please be advised that they will only accept cash and prices are likely to be high.
